Who we are

We are a group of parent carers of children and young people in Haringey, aged 0-25, who have additional needs.

We believe that with the right support and services they can attain their full potential and achieve positive life outcomes.

What we do

We represent the views, priorities and experiences of families like ours.

We work in partnership with local authorities, education bodies and health, social care and other service providers to influence how they commission, plan and deliver services to meet the needs of children and young people with additional needs.

How we do this

- We aim to have as many members and therefore as many voices as possible from across Haringey.
- We run information, consultation and discussion events
- We attend meetings with professionals to explain what parent carers and their children need and have representatives on strategic groups
- We are run by a steering group of parents whose children have a variety of different needs.



Who supports us?

Haringey Involve is funded by the **Department of Education**. We are a member of the National Network of Parent Carer Forums, which brings together the collective voice of families like ours from across England.

We also receive support from **my AFK** (formerly Action For Kids), a national charity supporting disabled children, young people and their families by providing mobility equipment as well as preparing young people with learning disabilities for life after school through accredited education, training and work experience programmes.
