Mike Wilson of Public Voice has sent us some more information about the Joint Partnership Board (JPB) setting up a Transitions Reference Group in the autumn – and this means any parent carer who has an interest can get involved by contacting Mike directly. He told us

“A Joint Adult Social Care Partnership Board (JPB) has been set up in Haringey which represents a range of service users and carers. It is really important that service users and parents/carers have an opportunity to make their views known to commissioners and policy makers in the Council and CCG and to the local Mental Health Trust. The channel for expressing these views will increasingly be through the Reference Groups to the Partnership Board. The new **Transition Reference Group** will be meeting in September and **we would welcome members to join us who have children who will be transitioning in to adult services in the next few years and those whose children have recently transitioned.** We will meet once every two months at a time and venue to suit the majority of members – daytime and evening meetings.
